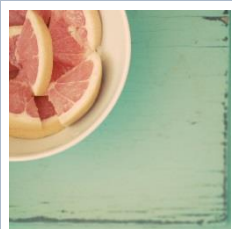

### Navigating SLC

Think Battleship. Salt Lake City streets are in a grid system with a number and then N, E, S, W indicating where on the grid a particular address is located. The grid starts at the intersection of Main and South Temple (Temple Square). For example, 600 S 700 E, is six streets south of Temple Square and seven streets east. If something online doesn't have both cardinal directions, you may have a hard time finding the address. Of course, it doesn't really help that we have streets with South and West in their proper name. We're sorry. Just use Siri like everyone else does.
